

We are excited to begin a new choir year at Christ Lutheran! (We had so much fun last year!) Choir will begin weekly rehearsals on Thursday, September 6 from 8-9 p.m. in the church sanctuary. We will be singing anthems on the first Sundays in October, November, December, February, March, and May, as well as on Christmas Eve, Maundy Thursday, and Easter. We will also again feature music during the sermon for our special May 5th Music Sunday. If you love music and enjoy singing, please join us!

You do NOT need to have a solo voice.

You do NOT have to be out of school; anyone **junior high age or older** may join. Whether you've been part of choir before or are considering it for the first time, singers are welcome to join us as we give praise to God through our music ministry. Questions? Call Lori Zylstra

Can you count to four? Do you know pink from blue? Do you know your right hand from your left hand? Can you keep a steady beat with other people? Are you starting first grade or

have completed at least the First Grade in school? If you answered "yes" to all those questions, you could ring tone chimes with Genesis Chimes!

Genesis is the first book of the Bible, but the word's meaning can be translated as "the beginning of" an item or time period. When the adult hand bell choir moved from tone chimes to hand bells, Genesis Chimes was formed to help train up younger ringers in basic ringing techniques and musicality, some of whom later moved into JuBellation. It is a beginning

choir (though most of my back row of adult ringers also play in JuBellation) and we are looking for new ringers this fall of any age above 7. If you are available on Thursday nights at 6:15, and would like to learn how to ring, please talk to Jan Kopischke after a worship service.

+ SUNDAYS AFTER PENTECOST +

This is the longest stretch of Sundays of the Christian church year known by many Christians as "Ordinary Time," "Time of the Church," or "Time after Pentecost." This time is neither watchful like Advent and Lent, nor celebrative like Christmas and Easter.

The Time After Pentecost relates to the time between the Age of the Apostles and the End of the World -- it relates to *now*, to the Church guided by the Holy Spirit, to our sanctification.

The season of Pentecost is bracketed by two major festival days. The first is *Holy Trinity Sunday* being the first Sunday after the Day of Pentecost. The second is *Christ the King Sunday* being the last Sunday in the season of Pentecost and of the church year. Both Sundays are given the color of white. The long series of Sundays in between are given the color of green representing growth as disciples of Jesus.

+ Christ the King Sunday +

On this final Sunday of the church year our gospel is Jesus' great story of judgment. In the end, the faithful are those who served Christ by ministering to those who are poor, hungry, naked, sick, or estranged. In the first reading God is the shepherd who seeks the lost, weak, and injured and feeds them with justice. We

gather this day to celebrate the reign of Christ and his victory over death, yet awaiting the consummation of all things yet to come. Acknowledging Christ as our merciful ruler, we go forth that his reign may be known in our loving words and deeds.
